JNUTA Condemn attempts to intimidate teachers of JNU

The JNUTA condemns in the strongest terms the orchestrated campaign being carried out against teachers of the University, in particular women teachers, with the sole purpose of terrorizing them. Through frivolous complaints against them for things that they do in discharging their responsibilities as teachers and administrators and vitriolic campaigns through the media including the social media, the security and liberty of teachers is being gravely threatened.

The JNUTA demands that the University Administration act promptly against those indulging in such criminal activity and ensure the safety and legitimate freedoms of teachers.

JNUTA also condemns in strongest terms the attacks on a meeting in Muzaffarpur in Bihar, which was to be addressed by Prof. S.N. Malakar and many other JNU Alumni. Though the meeting was ultimately held at another venue, the stone throwing and other intimidation tactics, when hundreds of unarmed people including many women were present at the meeting venue, can only be termed cowardly and dastardly.
