CIRCULAR

1. Advanced Life Support Vehicle hired by JNU is provided for use from inside the JNU Campus to the JNU Health Centre and from JNU Campus to any hospital in Delhi and NCT in case of emergency.
2. Patient Transport Vehicle hired by JNU is provided for use from inside the JNU Campus to the JNU Health Centre and from JNU Campus to any hospital in Delhi and NCT for non emergency cases.
3. If anybody from JNU including all beneficiaries requires ambulance from outside the Campus then Centralised Accident Trauma Services (CATS) can be called by dialing 102 or 1099 for all cases of medical emergencies /accidents / trauma / pregnancies / neonatal emergencies. It can be also available for shifting those patients who are coming by Train and Aeroplane and want the service of CATS ambulance from Bus Terminal, Railway Station and Airport free of cost in all types of medical emergencies. CATS ambulance can be called inside the Campus. It can also be called whenever the Advanced Life Support Vehicle is not available in the Campus. For any clarification dial 102 or 1099 which are toll free numbers.
4. The student will be picked from the hospital by the ambulance at night (after 8.00 P.M till 07.00 A.M). The student has to inform the driver of the ambulance over phone to bring them back to JNU Campus. It will be done in view of the safety concerns.
5. Practice of providing Ambulance to persons with disability for O.P.D treatment and Physiotherapy in addition to emergency will be continued. Ambulance will take them to the hospital and bring them back to JNU Campus at all time.
