CIRCULAR

Subject: Effective use of 'Aarogyasetu' App for breaking the chain of transmission of COVID-19 – reg.

In pursuance of the directions issued by the Govt. of India, Ministry of Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions Department of Personnel & Training vide Office MemorandumF. No. 1013/9/2014-Estt (A-III) dated 29th April, 2020, and Govt. of India, Ministry of Home Affairs vide Order No. 40-3/2020-DM-1 (A) dated 01.05.2020, regarding the subject cited above, all the University employees, students and residents of the JNU Campus are requested to follow the following guidelines:-

- 1. All the University employees (including outsourced staff), students and residents of the JNU Campus should download 'Aarogyasetu' App on their mobile phones, immediately to keep themselves safe and secure.
- 2. All those employees who are working in emergency/essential services should check the 'Aarogyasetu' App before coming to office and they must review their status on 'Aarogyasetu' App and commute only when the app shows 'safe' or 'low risk' status.
- 3. In case the 'Aarogyasetu' App shows a message that he/she has a 'moderate' or 'high risk' calculated on the basis of bluetooth proximity ("recent contact with infected person") he/she should not come to office and self isolate for 14 days to till the status becomes 'safe or 'low risk' and information to this effect may immediately be given to the undersigned through their respective Heads/Incharge.
- 4. All Heads of the respective Departments/Sections should also ensure the compliance of above directions that these instructions are being strictly followed by the officialsunder their control who are working in emergency/essential services.
